We propose that the Trust will appoint a minority of governors (2) to all the founder schools within the Trust with the exception of Suffolk One where the Trust will appoint a majority of Trust governors to the Suffolk One Governing Body. These Governors will have the expertise to help the partnership make our vision a reality for all our young people. In all schools, with the exception of Suffolk One, these Trust Governors would not have overall control and one third of governors would still be elected parents. To ensure the involvement of parent of students at Suffolk One a Parent Council would be established.
